HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

Thiru. J.K.K.Nattraja, the founder of these educational institutions is a noted industrialist, educationalist and philanthropist and was the close follower of former Chief Minister Thiru. K. Kamaraj. He followed the visions of Thiru. Kamaraj, like educating the poor people in village. In 1952, he gave full financial support to start an elementary school at Komarapalayam village and in 1965 started a Girls Higher Secondary School followed by J.K.K.Nattraja Nursery and Primary School in the year 1969. He was a social reformer and strived for the upliftment of women by starting the Arts and Science College for women in 1974.

J.K.K.Natarajah founded the J.K.K.Rangammal Charitable Trust in the year 1969 which runs many educational institutions now and has fast become a pioneering leader in educating the masses, in diverse fields. One among them is J.K.K.Nattaraja College of Pharmacy and Research Institute, Komarapalayam established in the year 1985. Later, with the same vision he established J.K.K.Nattaraja Dental College in the year 1987. Sre Sakthimayeil Institute of Nursing and Research, J.K.K.Nattaraja College of Engineering and Technology, J.K.K.Nattaraja Play School were also established then by the Managing Trustee Srimathi. N. SENDAMARAAI who is an extra conceptual personality with an exemplary vision and guidance in developing these institutions. The whole campus situated in a picturesque surrounding, facing the National Highway-544 in Komarapalayam.

Komarapalayam is an industrial town, located on the border of Namakkal, Salem and Erode districts of TamilNadu, flanked by River Cauvery on one side and National Highway-544 which connects Chennai via Salem with Cochin and Trivandrum on the other side. The institution is located 2 kms (East) away from Komarapalayam along the NH-544.

All the departments in Pharmacy College are active in research and most are judged to be of International standards in their research. It is no surprise that the college as a whole attracts large number of students from various countries like Kenya, Sudan, Saudi Arabia, Palestine, Mauritius, Oman, Muscat etc.

IMPORTANCE OF PHARMACY PROFESSION

The field of pharmaceutical sciences has made tremendous advances during the last century. Pharmacy is a profession that requires the synergy of knowledge that has already been developed by many other disciplines. The members of pharmacy profession work hand in glove with other profession related scientists to apply new and old scientific principles to produce pharmaceuticals and medicines to the public at affordable prices. PAYMENT OF FEES

Tuition fee to be paid on September and March in every year. Tuition fee and other fee should not be paid later than the stipulated date. If a student fails to pay the fee within the stipulated date, a penal fee will be collected. If the fee is not paid within a month after the stipulated date, the student's name will be removed from register. If re-admitted, in addition to the fee and fine, a readmission fee will also be charged.

Certificates will be issued only after the clearance of all dues and clearance certificate should be produced from the concerned head of the departments.

No duplicate certificate will be issued unless certificate by a competent authority to the effect that the original certificate was actually lost to be produced.

ATTENDANCE

1. Students should secure a minimum of 90% attendance to appear for exam.
2. Students must attend the college regularly and punctually on all working days. No student should absent themselves from the college without applying leave.
3. A student who absents himself should submit an application in the prescribed form to their class in charge. Students residing in the college hostel must submit their applications with warden's authorization.
4. In case of sudden illness, the application should be submitted in person to the Principal along with a medical certificate as early as possible.
5. If a student absent for a continuous period of three working days without leave permission, their name will be forwarded by the class teachers to the Principal to be struck off from the rolls, unless he / she convinces satisfactorily that their failure to obtain leave was unavoidable.
6. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of every period. A student who is not in the class when attendance is taken shall be marked absent and shall lose attendance for that class.

GENERAL CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOUR

1. Students should compulsorily maintain a formal dress code.
2. Students must learn the names and faces of all teachers and other staff concerned and due respect to be given.
3. Students should not leave the class room without permission.
4. Students are required to spend their leisure in the library.
5. Students should not make any noise while moving from class to class.
6. Students will not be permitted to enter the college / office without permission.
7. Students are expected to read notice put up on the college notice board, ignorance of any notice thus put up will not be accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with it.
9. No notice will be circulated among the 'students' or put up on the notice board without the written sanction of the Principal.
10. Girls should tie up their hairs and follow the dress code.

LABORATORY RULES

1. Bag and related personal belongings should not be carried inside the laboratory.
2. Laboratory record books should preferably be written up at desk areas. However, laboratory note books are permitted so that all relevant data can be reliably and accurately recorded while carrying out experimental work.
3. Laboratory coats (properly washed) must be worn at all times in all laboratory areas.
4. Disposable protective gloves should generally be worn as necessary, when working at the lab particularly when handling chemicals, (or) any biological material likely to contain micro- organisms or harmful.
5. Follow very sincerely the directions of the teacher inside the lab to understand the subject and to get rid of hazards.
6. Students breaking any article (or) apparatus will be required to replace it. The decision of the head of the department and Principal will be final.
7. Girls should put their hair inside the apron.

THE COLLEGE LIBRARY

The pharmacy library now contains a variety of heads covering all areas of pharmaceutical subjects, 30 National Journals and 35 International Journals. There is a reading room attached to the library where in dailies, Magazines and periodicals of good order are available. E-Books about 3000 numbers are added beauty of the library.

LIBRARY RULES

1. The library has 3 sections (a) Reference (b) Lending and (c) Reading.
2. Reference books may be referred only within the premises of the library. They cannot be taken by the students from the library at any time.
3. Lending section: All books except those marked "Reference" belong to the lending section.
4. The library will be kept open on all working days from 8.30 am to 8.00 pm. It will remain closed on Sundays and other declared holidays.
5. Every student must possess his / her Library card while making use of the library and produce the same to the library staff on entering the library.
6. Complete silence must be maintained in the library.
7. Students can get the books such as text books, reference books, and reference sources for reading in the reading room against his / her library and If such book is taken without the permission of the librarian then a fine of Rs. 10/- will be charged and no book will be issued to him / her in future.

8. When books are issued, students should check the pages of the issued books and if the pages are found missing, they should report the same to the librarian before leaving the counter. On returning the book if pages are found missing the last borrower of the book shall be held accountable for the missing pages and shall be fined.
9. Students are required to handle study material very carefully, and should not mark library books with pencil or pen, tear the pages or spoil.
10. The librarian may recall any book from a student at any time.
11. Students should leave their own books and belongings at the entrance before they enter the library.
12. The library books should be returned on or before the due date stamped on the date slip in the book.
13. In case a reader loses a book he / she should replace the book. In case the book cannot be replaced; the current price of the book and an additional charge will be collected.
14. The college leaving certificate or Transfer Certificate will be issued to student only after he / she has returned all the library books and library card.
15. Students are strictly prohibited to use their cell phones in the library.

COLLEGE EXAMINATION

1. Candidates are expected to be in their seats on the bell [9.30 a.m and 12.30 p.m.] No one can enter the hall 30 minutes after the commencement of the examination. No candidate can receive a question paper before taking her/him assigned seat in the hall.
2. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall before the expiry of at least half an hour after the question paper has been given out.
3. Candidates for all the examination should write their answers on both sides of the book supplied.
4. Everyone should bring their own pen, pencil, rubber, and scale.
5. No paper other than the question paper should be taken out of the examination hall.
6. Roll number, class and subject of paper should be clearly indicated on the answer papers.
7. When additional paper is needed, candidates should stand in their places and thus call attention.
8. Follow the detailed rules and regulation displayed during the examination.

RAGGING

- ▶ It is offensive to rag. The Government of Tamil Nadu has passed an enactment under Act No.7 of 1997. The act is called "The Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997".
- ▶ Ragging in any action or form is punishable with imprisonment up to a term of two years. Dismiss from the institution and a fine of **Rs. 10,000/-** and above.
